

# **WORLD SAILING TITLE TO BOB MOSBACHER**

**PALMA DE MALLORCA, Spain, Oct. 5 (UPI)—Robert Mosbacher of the United States, at the helm of Aphrodite, won the Dragon Class world sailing championship today by 1 point.**

**Aphrodite finished fifth in the seventh and final race today, but it was enough for the overall victory. Second over all, pending the results of protests, the Soviet Union's Nord, steered by U. Unismov, which finished 12th in today's race.**

**The winner of the final race was Age Birch of Denmark, piloting Chok. Second place went to Axel Holm, also of Denmark, aboard May Britt. Arthur Boyes of Australia, aboard Ann, was third.**

**Mosbacher, a 42-year-old oil executive from Houston, was the runner-up in the 1967 world championships in Toronto. His crew was made up of George Francisco of Houston and David Savillen of Fort Lauderdale, Fla.**
